Learning to fly - Your questions answered.

What's the first step?

If you have never been in a light aircraft before then your first encounter is likely to be a 'Trial Lesson'; a one-off flight which is designed to give you an initial experience of flying a small aeroplane. Usually gifted in the form of a voucher, this is the perfect introduction to flying and prices start from only £99 for 30 minutes.



I've had a Trial Lesson and am definitely interested. What's next?

We offer an all-inclusive, 'Introduction to Flying' package consisting of the first 3 lessons of your course. This is the ideal way to get a real feel for the service we offer with a limited financial commitment. At just £399, it's a cost-effective way to kick-start your training.

I'm convinced! How do I start?

Great news! You're going to need:

- A school membership (£120 per year).
- A 'Pilot's Starter Kit' which includes all the mandatory equipment you will need up to and including your first solo flight (£223).
- Funds to cover your flight training (from £134 per hour) and landing fees (these typically cost around £15 each). Discounts are available when purchasing 10 or more hours in advance.

Are there any other costs?

Yes. Learning to fly is not cheap, but it is incredibly rewarding. In addition to the above costs you will need to pay for written examinations, an aviation medical certificate, ground school fees, test fees, CAA licensing fees, flight equipment and study materials. There are lots of variables, and every student pilot faces different challenges, but overall you should budget to spend (very approximately) around £12,000.



What courses do Merseyflight offer?

We offer training courses for the Private Pilot's Licence (PPL) and the Light Aeroplane Pilot's Licence (LAPL). The PPL is the standard licence and allows more flexibility for those who may wish to do more advanced training whilst the LAPL is ideal for those who either only want to fly as a hobby or are limited by medical issues.

The PPL course consists of a minimum of 45 hours flight training (30 hours for the LAPL) and 9 multiple choice exams. The courses are virtually identical and no prior experience or qualifications are required to enrol.

What happens after I've qualified?

As a pilot's licence holder you will be able to fly as Pilot in Command on aeroplanes for non-commercial operations. Additionally, you can continue your training with one of our post-PPL courses and learn to fly at night or in marginal weather conditions.
